

Children must bring one of the following to participate:

- Smartphone / tablet for Pokémon go for casual trading
- a nintendo 3DS to play Ultra Sun and Ultra Moon for battling
- pokemon trading cards for causal trading
- a complete 60 card deck for battling: this can be purchased at Target, Walmart, etc. for \$11.99 or they can provide their own.

Activities for children who do not have one of the following:

- Pokémon coloring sheets
- Pokémon jigsaw puzzles
- my personal GameCube and computer monitor with 4 controllers for free play

Activities for children who did bring the required materials:

- Ultra Sun and Ultra Moon video game tournament
- Pokémon trading card tournament
