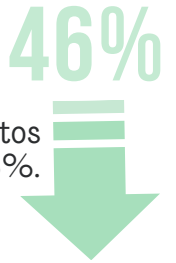

## HIGHLIGHTS:

**Part I Crimes increased 21% over last year.**

Why the big increase? Shoplifting!

If we remove the increase in shoplifting cases this year, our part 1 crimes would be down 20%!



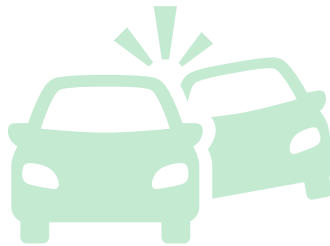
## CALLS FOR SERVICE AND RESPONSE TIMES:

Calls for service increased 5% this year over the same time period last year. The average response time to a non-emergency call is 5.32 minutes.

**ARRESTS: Total arrests increased 34%** compared to the same time period last year. Detectives cleared 48% more cases by arrest.

## VEHICLE COLLISIONS:

Vehicle collisions dropped by 7% over the same time period in 2022.



## TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT:

56% WARNINGS  
44% CITATIONS

Follow-up investigations assigned to patrol and cleared by arrest **increased by 81%** over the year to date in 2022.



## MULTI USE PATH PATROL:

**5% INCREASE**  
in multi-use path patrol this year

**72% INCREASE**  
in warnings issued to golf carts this year

**30% INCREASE**  
in citations issued to golf carts this year
